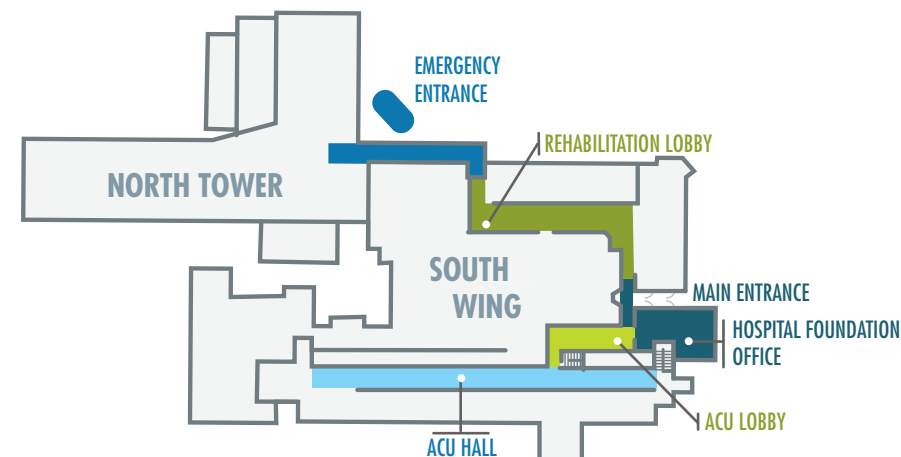

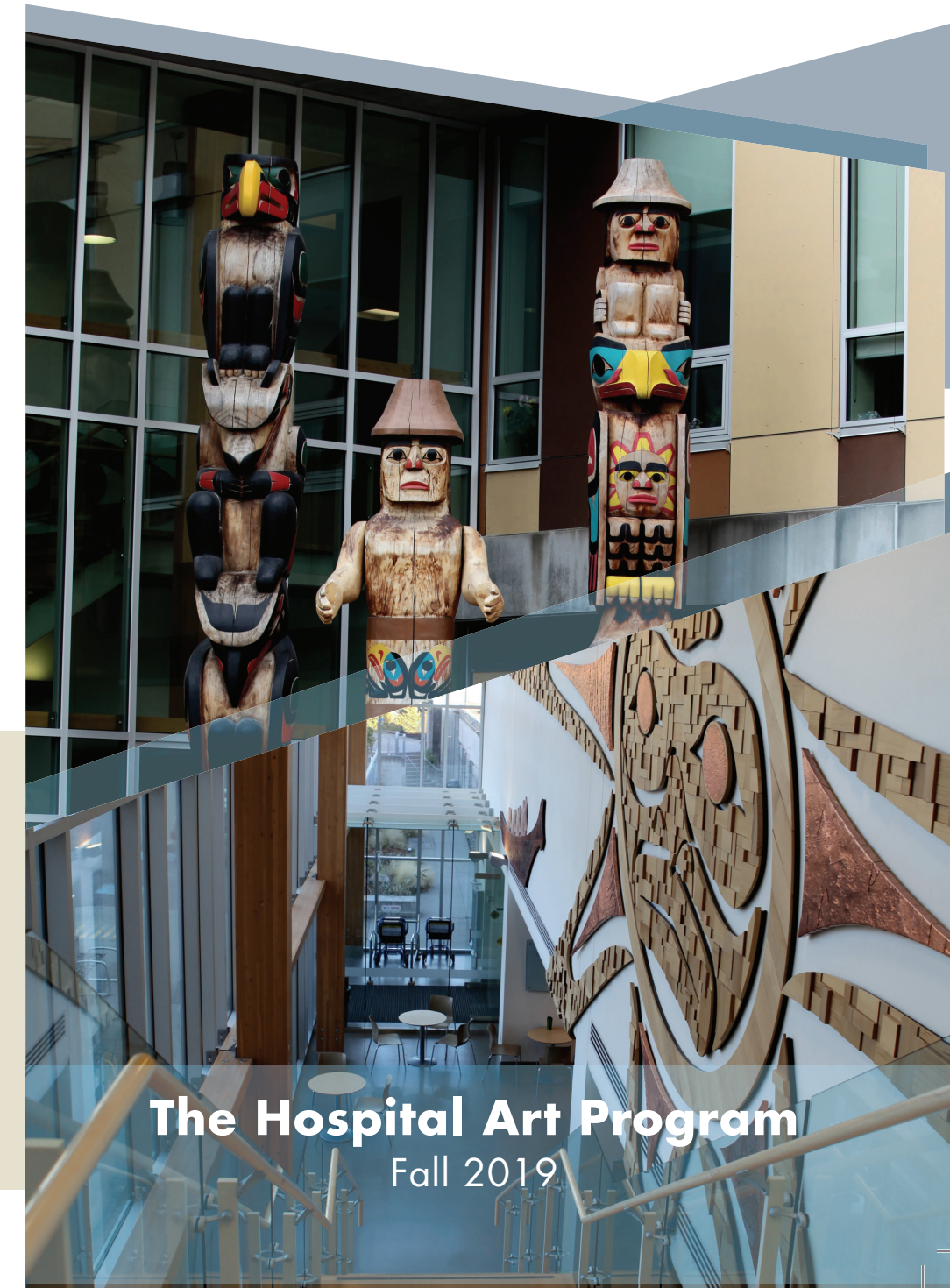

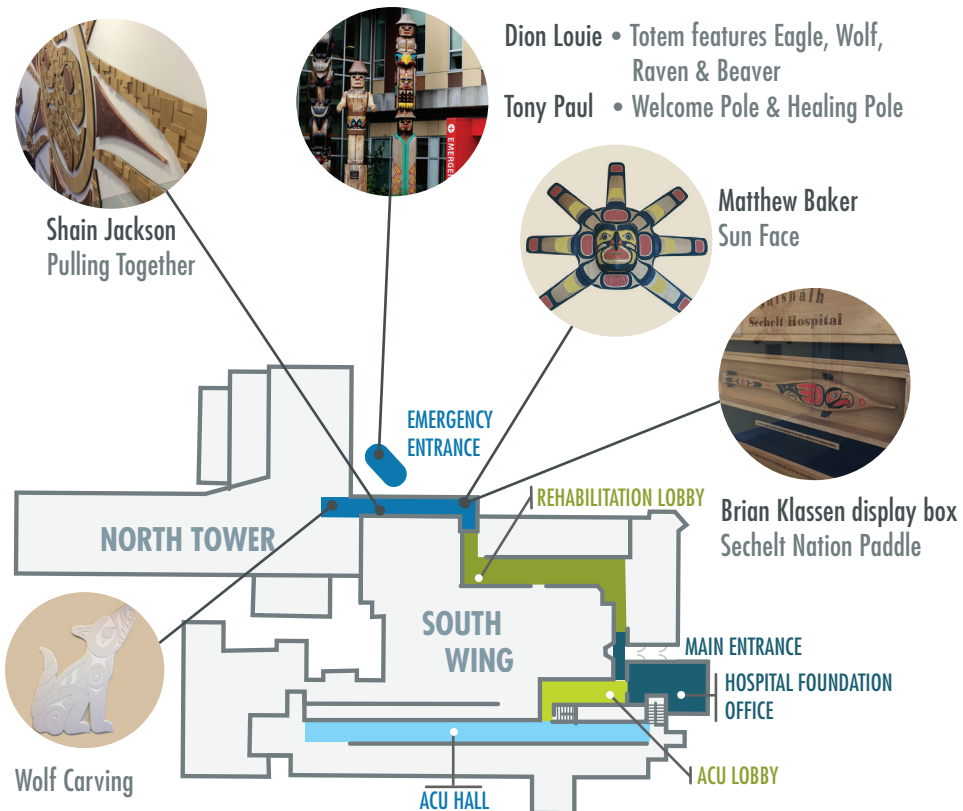
An Art Program Committee, which includes representatives from the

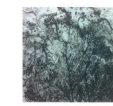

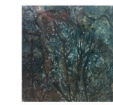

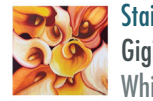
